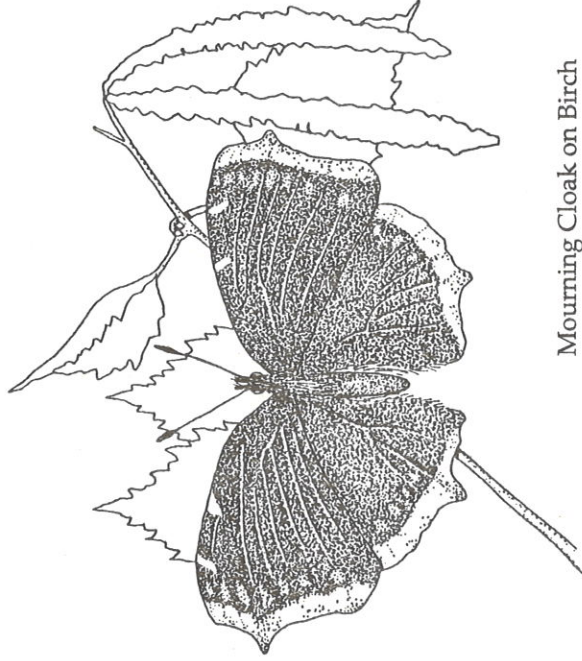

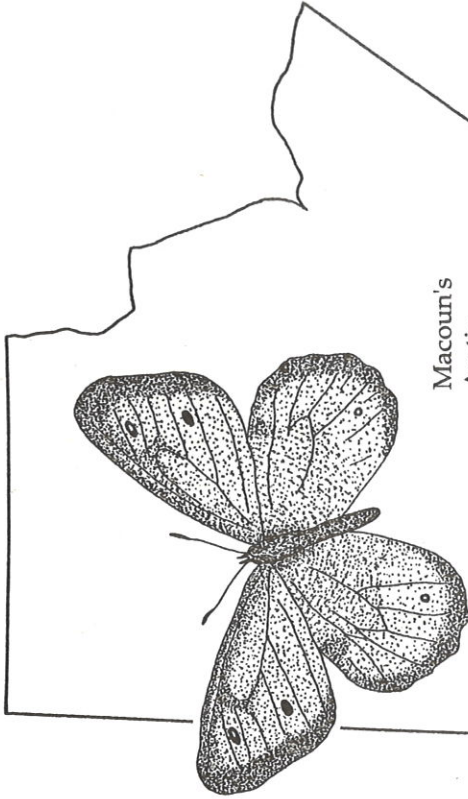

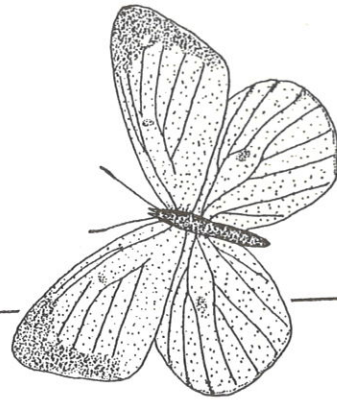

Introduction

This *Field Checklist of The Skippers & Butterflies of Manitoba* is a companion to the 290-page book, *The Butterflies of Manitoba*, by Paul Klassen, Richard Westwood, Bill Preston and Brian McKillop. The book was published in 1989 by the Manitoba Museum of Man and Nature in Winnipeg.

- ❖ Butterfly watching with binoculars is best on sunny days at 20-25°C, with a light wind following an overnight rain. Butterflies are attracted to moisture on gravel roads and woodland trails, and to nectar in prairie and garden flowers.
- ❖ Each species in this checklist is listed by its common name, followed by the book's page number where its descriptive text and range map are located, then a plate and numbers where coloured photographs provide an identification parade.
- ❖ In Canada there are 64 species of Skippers and 208 Butterflies. In Manitoba 33 Skippers and 111 Butterflies have been found. Since the publication of the above book, new records have been added to the list:

Common Sooty Wing *Pholisora catullus*

Sachem *Atalopedes campestris*

Hackberry Butterfly *Asterocampa celtis*

Little Sulphur *Eurema lisa*

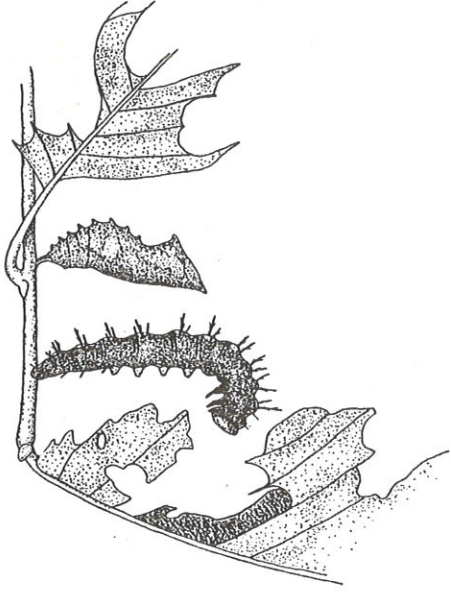
Mexican Fritillary *Euptoieta hegesia*

Blue *Plebejus rusticus* from central and southern Manitoba.
